

Higher Education - Selected Teaching, Curriculum & Faculty Development Projects

As a Senior Lecturer and Curriculum Developer within the Faculty of Foreign Languages and Translation Studies, I combined teaching with curriculum development, faculty professional learning, program evaluation, and educational innovation.

While most initiatives were developed within my home faculty, my work also involved collaboration with the Faculties of Economics, Law, Management and Engineering, and Psychology. The selected projects below reflect both faculty-level responsibilities and cross-faculty collaboration.

1. Curriculum Modernization & Cross-Faculty Collaboration (2018-2022).

Contributed to the review, redesign, and evaluation of English-language curricula and assessments for students across multiple academic programs. Collaborated with the Faculties of Economics, Law, Management and Engineering, and Psychology to adapt curriculum content and learning outcomes to students' academic and professional contexts, institutional requirements, and evolving workforce needs.

2. English Language Textbook Development (2020).

Collaborated with a team of faculty instructors to design and develop an English-language textbook for university students, developing instructional content, learning activities, and materials aligned with program curriculum and learner needs.

3. Student Feedback System (2020-2022).

Contributed to the review and redesign of the student feedback process, developing a more structured approach to collecting and using feedback to inform teaching effectiveness, learner experience, and curriculum improvement.

4. Alumni Employment & Curriculum Alignment (2018-2020)

Analyzed graduate employment outcomes within the Faculty of Foreign Languages and Translation Studies to identify gaps between student preparation and workplace expectations. Used findings to inform curriculum improvements and faculty professional development, strengthening the connection between teaching practices and graduates' career readiness.

5. AI Tools & Educational Technology for Faculty (2023-2025)

Contributed as a project team member to the development of an AI adoption initiative tailored to faculty needs. Supported project development and facilitation, helping instructors explore practical applications of AI tools in teaching and academic workflows.

6. Digital Teaching & Blended Learning (2021-2025)

Designed and facilitated professional development for instructors within the Faculty of Foreign Languages and Translation Studies, supporting the adoption of digital pedagogy, blended learning, learner-centred instructional approaches, and educational technologies.

7. Diversity, Equity & Inclusion in Teaching (2019-2020)

Initiated, designed, and facilitated professional development focused on inclusive teaching practices for instructors in the Faculty of Foreign Languages and Translation Studies and the Faculty of Psychology, including the department responsible for preparing future school teachers.

Supported instructors in identifying barriers to learner participation and applying more inclusive approaches to teaching diverse learners, while facilitating discussion around questions and resistance associated with changing established teaching practices.
